

Hole-in-One Policy- Ladies Golf Section

Effective 2020.

A hole-in-one assessment of \$5.00 is billed annually and applied to the Hole-in-One Fund. Should the Hole-in-One fund become depleted due to multiple hole-in-one achievements, additional amounts may be assessed to replenish the fund. An annual statement of the Hole-in-One Fund will be presented by the Treasurer at the Annual Closing Meeting. Only members who have paid their hole-in-one insurance are eligible for the Hole-in-One Award.

Award for Member

A member who scores a Hole-in-One ("HIO") at Dundas Valley's Championship Course will receive the following award:

\$300.00 Pro-Shop or Dining Credit (OR combination thereof – not to exceed \$300 in total)

+

\$200.00 Food and Beverage Credit for celebration on that day or a day of the Individual's choice but must be consumed all day specified

How to Claim your Hole- in-One Award

Your scorecard is to be attested by others in your group and a Golf Professional and then forwarded to the General Manager.

When you get your hole-in-one, there is a form available in the Half-Way house to be filled out which entitles the member to receive the \$200.00 Food and Beverage credit for celebratory purposes as well as register the HIO to receive the Pro-Shop or Dining credit (\$300.00). The latter credit will be provided to the member by the Office.

Hole-in-One Scored at Other Courses in Ontario

For a hole-in-one scored at other regulation courses in Ontario, the lady member is entitled to receive \$100 which must be spent on refreshments that day. Receipts or chits will be required to support the amount. Please contact the Dundas Valley Pro Shop to confirm that the course played is a regulation course. Your scorecard is to be attested by others in your group and the Course's Golf Professional, if available and then forwarded to the General Manager.
